The Bootcamp

1. The objectives of the Bootcamp are:
 - a. To share diverse perspectives and challenges in education research at the frontier of knowledge..
 - b. To increase research capacities by incorporating new knowledge and experience.
 - c. To create interdisciplinary and open networks to build solutions to address society's holistic challenges and needs.
2. Participants will be expected to engage with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, adopting critical perspectives in their analysis, which must be proactive and informed by a global vision. Research and innovation capabilities will be further fostered by exploring opportunities for integrated applied research and publication through networking.
3. The Bootcamp will focus on the following themes:
 - a. Defining interdisciplinary frontier educational research.
 - b. UN Sustainable Development Goals and multidisciplinary research.
 - c. Open science in the framework of sustainability.
 - d. The use of technological tools for analysis.
 - e. Academic and scientific networks to mobilize knowledge-based responses with social impact.

4. The expected outputs resulting from this Bootcamp include:
 - a. A joint educational research network between Latin America and Europe, with the opportunity to connect as well through The Knowledge Equity Network (KEN).
 - b. An edited electronic open book with a publisher within SPI-CSIC # top 2 levels in publisher prestige that will capture the contributions of Participants.
5. Participants will have the opportunity to develop:
 - a. An enhanced understanding of the use of technological resources for research production.
 - b. An increased competence in collaborative knowledge production and dissemination through impact publications.

The Call

1. The Bootcamp will be of interest to:
 - a. Doctoral students and Thesis Supervisors interested in producing and disseminating unpublished research in Education or other fields connected to Frontier Knowledge (for instance, computing or public policy).
 - b. University educators, researchers, and leaders interested in producing and disseminating unpublished research in Frontier Knowledge linked with Education, especially within the framework of the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
 - c. Professionals from the academic, governmental, business, and social sectors, interested in producing and disseminating unpublished research on other topics related to UN Sustainable Development Goals, for example, justice and peace, water, or sustainable energy, providing that this research possesses a precise educational dimension or a connection with Frontier Knowledge.
2. Applicants to the Bootcamp must be able to commit themselves to write a research report of 8-10 pages capturing their outputs for the edited electronic open book resulting from the Bootcamp.
3. Participants will be expected:
 - a. To submit an abstract as part of their application in Spanish or English.
 - b. To submit a full text ahead of the Bootcamp in Spanish or English.
 - c. To enrich and expand their full text by embedding the learning and interactions generated at the Bootcamp.
 - d. To submit their final research report for the edited electronic open book from the above work. The language for this final submission will be determined later in October 2023.
4. Participants whose final research report for the edited electronic open book is accepted for publication by the editors will receive an accreditation of 40 hours, whereas the rest of the Participants will be accredited for 20 hours.
5. Information about the submission rules and academic style of the abstracts, the full-text document, and the final research report for the edited electronic open book are provided on the webpage of the Bootcamp.
6. The languages of the Bootcamp will be English and Spanish.

Location, Attendance, and Travel

1. The Bootcamp will be held at Innovation Hub Europe (Institute for the Future of Education, Tecnológico de Monterrey) in Comillas, Cantabria, Spain.
2. The program includes a welcome cocktail and networking event, live conferences, and interactive activities with experts.
3. Applicants to the Bootcamp must be available to travel to the Bootcamp, which will take place between October 29th (5 pm start) and 31st (2.30 pm finish), 2023, and attend all activities of the Bootcamp.
4. The nearest airports to Comillas, Cantabria, are Santander, Bilbao, and Asturias. These are connected to international airports such as Madrid and Barcelona.
5. The Participants of the Bootcamp will cover registration, travel, accommodation, and other travel-related expenses.
